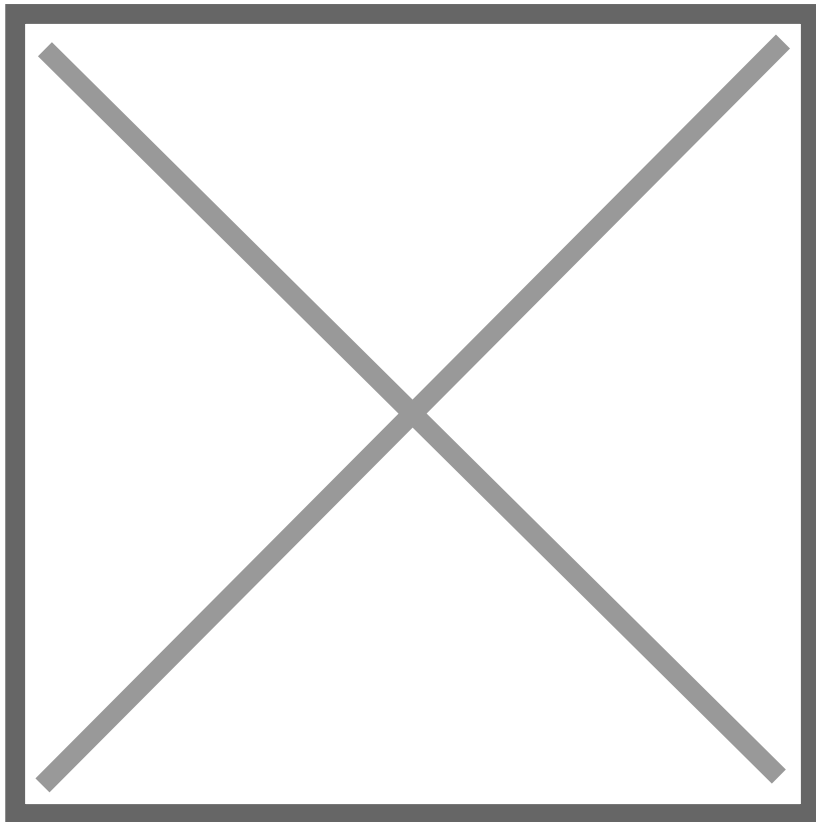


05 Diogenes: Challenging Philosophy
